Class I – Diagnostic & Preventive Exams, Prophys, Fluoride, X-rays, Sealants No co-pays for regular exams and x- rays!	 Most services are paid at 100%. A co-pay of \$15 is charged for problem-focused limited evaluations. Sealants are \$5 per tooth. Fees for space maintainers range from \$24 to \$34.
Class II – Restorative Restorations, Endodontics, Periodontics, Oral Surgery	 Many services are paid at 100%. There are no co-pays for fillings. Resin composite fillings in posterior teeth are optional. No co-pays for root canals. No copays for most other endodontic treatment. No co-pays for periodontal maintenance, root planning or for site specific therapy. No co-pays for most other periodontal treatment. Most oral surgery is covered with no co-pay. Optional treatments may have additional co-pays.
Class III – Major Crowns, Dentures, Partials and Bridges	 Copayments required for most services. Co-pays for crowns range from \$47 to \$238. Co-pays for dentures range from \$305 to \$530. Co-pays for denture repair and relining. Co-pays for the various bridge elements similar to those for crowns. Optional treatments may have additional co-pays.
Orthodontia plan H Covers Adults & Dependent Child(ren) to age 26	50% Payable to a Maximum Lifetime Benefit of \$ 2,000
Monthly Composite Rate	\$90.60

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ABOUT DELTACARE

The DeltaCare[®] plan offers you and your family an affordable choice for quality dental care. Washington Dental Service has contracted with a large, select network of dentists (both primary care and specialists) who have agreed to provide a full range of benefits and high-quality care.

ACCESSING CARE

How to use your DeltaCare plan

When you sign up for DeltaCare, you will complete an enrollment form indicating your primary dental office choice. After you have enrolled, you will receive a membership card that will have the address and telephone number of your DeltaCare dentist. To receive all necessary dental care, simply contact your assigned DeltaCare primary care dentist to make an appointment.

Your DeltaCare dentist is responsible for coordinating all specialty care. He/she will either perform the specialty treatment or refer you to a DeltaCare network specialist. In some cases, your dentist may refer you to a non-network specialist. The DeltaCare plan will not cover dental services that are not performed by your assigned DeltaCare office or properly referred to a DeltaCare specialist.

Changing dentists

You may change DeltaCare dentists by contacting the Washington Dental Service DeltaCare client services team at (800) 650-1583 to request a change. The request must be made by the 20th of the month for you to be eligible by the first day of the following month with your newly chosen DeltaCare dentist.

Finding a dentist

You can find a participating DeltaCare dentist in your area by visiting the Washington Dental Service Web site at **DeltaDentalWA.com/WEA**. Click on the *Patients* tab and then on the *Find a Dentist* tab to begin your search. Be sure to select the DeltaCare plan and follow the prompts. Our DeltaCare client services representatives will assist you in the transfer, which will take effect the first day of the following month.

Pediatric Dental Care

It is assumed that all children will be visiting their assigned dentist. If there is a clinical reason the assigned dentist cannot treat your child, a referral to a pediatric dentists is required. Without this referral 100% of the treatment will be the subscriber's responsibility. Benefits for dependent children through age three at a pediatric dentist are covered at 100% after the appropriate co-pay. Benefits for dependent children age four and over at a pediatric dentist are covered at 50% after the appropriate co-pay.

Visiting non-DeltaCare dentists

You are responsible for any dental bills incurred from dental treatment received from non-DeltaCare dentists. Washington Dental Service will reimburse up to \$100 for out-of-area urgent care received from licensed dentists for procedures to alleviate pain.
