

## Founder's Scholarship Program

Ann Pence and Dennis Pence established this renewable scholarship in 2000 to benefit children of Coldwater Creek employees who enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited college or university, or vocational-technical school.

Following is information about this program and instructions on applying for the scholarship.

- Applications will be accepted only from children of salaried, full-time hourly or part time hourly employees of Coldwater Creek Inc. Seasonal and temporary employees are not eligible for this program.
- Eligible applicants must enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited college or university or vocational-technical school.
- Three scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$2,000 each.
- Students must maintain a GPA of 3.0.
- Families must demonstrate financial need.
- The following information must be submitted for application for the scholarship.
  - Coldwater Creek Founders Scholarship application form
  - Copies of ACT or SAT scores
  - Official high school or college transcript (whichever is applicable)
  - Demonstrated financial need
    - ✓ Estimated cost of school for one year
    - ✓ Verification of parents' income
    - ✓ Number of dependents being supported by parents
    - ✓ Other sources of income to be used to pay for school

Application forms may be requested from your Human Resources office and returned no later than March 31st each year.
